Wednesday 3 February 2010 Makara Windfarm Visit

Meridian, an electricity company committed to sustainable generation, switched on the turbines at Makara on 29th April 2009. When fully operational at the end of 2009, the 62-turbine development will have a capacity of 143 megawatts and will power the equivalent of 70,000 average New Zealand homes: that's all the homes within the territorial boundaries of Wellington City.
